

EARTH TREMOR AT CANBERRA

Many Buildings Shifted

CANBERRA, Monday.

A violent earth tremor was experienced at Canberra at 8 o'clock this morning, being the fourth within a week. Buildings shook and trees vibrated, while in a number of instances furniture is said to have been shifted about the floors of rooms.

The tremor was felt at Parliament House, shopping centres, and in all hotels.

Dr. Woodrogh, Commonwealth Geologist, attributed the disturbance to a slight shifting of the earth crust near Lake George.

Half an hour later a disturbance was felt at Collector, 35 miles away. Black Heath also reported a similar visitation.
